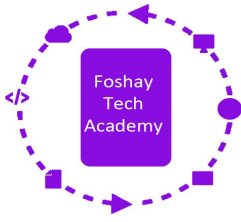
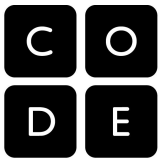

WHAT: The Tech Fair will engage the outside community and middle school students to experience computer science through reviewing and interacting with the seniors' semester long projects that address or help solve an issue in the community. Sample projects include experimenting with e-textiles and Arduinos, a water conservation game, and gamifying school. In addition juniors will show off their games in JavaScript and sophomores will be available to help middle school students log in and participate in online Hour of Code tutorials.

Following the tech fair we will have some time for selected guests to speak to the importance of computer science education.

The [Hour of Code](#) is a one-hour introduction to computer science, designed to demystify code and show that anybody can learn the basics. The Hour of Code is organized by Code.org, a public 501c3 non-profit dedicated to expanding participation in computer science by making it available in more schools, and increasing participation by women and underrepresented students of color. An unprecedented coalition of partners have come together to support the Hour of Code.
